Make-It Time


Since we are celebrating our Church Anniversary, and God's faithfulness to us, why not have a go at making some fun **PARTY DECORATIONS** like these?!

Gather some supplies, like coloured paper, tape and string, or use our template below to get you started on a party hat.



DIY PARTY HAT!

You will need:
-This template printed out (optional, on card)
-scissors
-textas/pencils
-sticky tape
-stickers/pompoms/glitter/anything else to make it bright
and colourful!
-streamers/curling ribbon



Method:

1. Cut out hat along the black lines
2. Colour in/decorate/put on stickers etc
3. Make into a cone shape by placing the black star onto the smiley face and stick down with tape.
4. Add ribbon/pompom to the tip of the hat
5. stick ribbon/elastic onto the small dots to help you tie on the hat

Chocolate Coconut Cake



Ingredients

- 250g butter, melted
- ½ cup cocoa powder
- 1⅓ cups castor sugar
- 3 eggs
- 1 ½ desiccated coconut
- 1 ½ cups self-raising flour
- ¾ cup milk

Method

1. Pre-heat oven to 180° on Bake setting.
2. Grease and line a 24cm round cake tin
3. Place all ingredients into a bowl and mix until smooth.
4. Bake for ~40 mins, check with a skewer, and bake for ~10mins more or until skewer comes out clean.
5. Cool on wire rack
6. Ice with simple chocolate icing or dust with icing sugar and serve with cream!
